MUSEUM ABOUT THE GLORIOUS HISTORY & ACHIEVEMENTS OF DR. ALAGAPPA CHETTIAR



Vallal Dr. Alagappan Museum is a museum dedicated to Sir Alagappa Chettiar, an educationalist, philanthropist, and businessman. This Museum is opened at the Alagappa University campus in Karaikudi, Sivaganga district to mark the celebration of the 108th birth anniversary of Sir Alagappa Chettiar.



At the Vallal Dr. Alagappan Museum, we can find the various historical photographs and memoirs of Sir Alagappa Chettiar, his life and achievements, and different types of objects and belongings used by him which are highly antique. This museum is well maintained by the Alagappa University trust and family.



Vallal Dr. Alagappan Museum also has a 'Tamil Cultural Center', which showcases the history of classic Tamil and Chettinad culture and traditions.



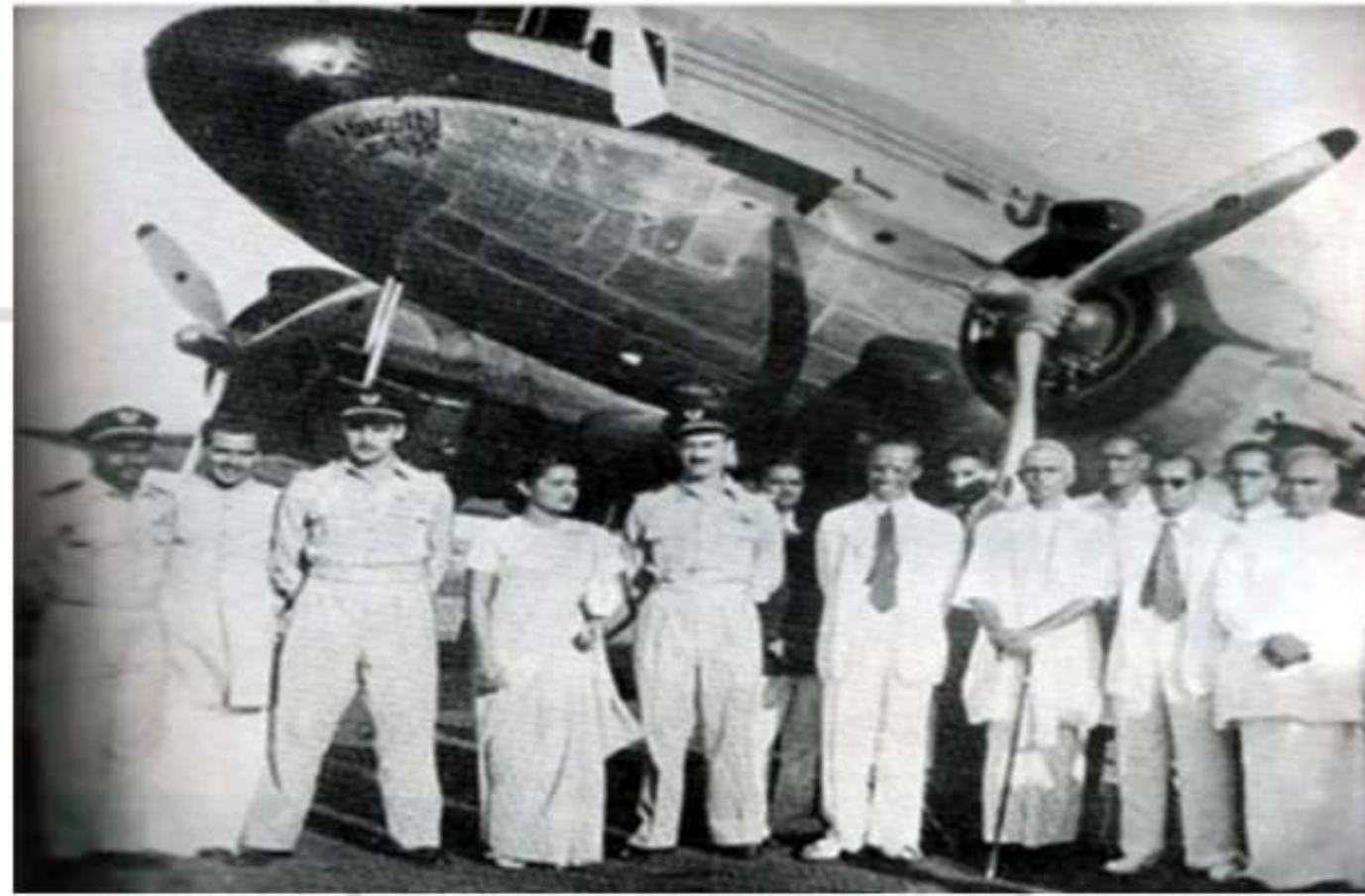
It was established to nurture, preserve and propagate the rich Tamil tradition and culture. The center is gathering, cataloging, and displaying proof of our great Tamil culture's long history. Dr Chettiar always had a fascination with flying, and when he was in London, he obtained a pilot's license in Croydon. Years later, in 1947, this very fascination gave India the Jupiter Airlines.

Dr Vairavan says that during one particular mission, one of the Jupiter Airlines planes crashed. "One of his managers came to him and said, Sir, the plane has crashed. The insurance company did not cover the crash, as the plane was only insured for civilian duties."

His only and immediate response was — 'We have another plane, send that'. So it was never about the money for him. He was just concerned with doing the right thing. "The Hindu times reported that in 1948, Jupiter Airways received its license to fly passenger routes from Meenambakkam, which became among the first few cities in the country to have an airport.

"When he was active in the stock market, he bought over Jupiter Airways, which had a fleet of Dakota aircrafts. He started the airlines for mass transit," his grandson says. At the onset of the Partition of India, Dr Chettiar was the first to offer his aircrafts to the government to evacuate families from Pakistan. The Indian Army was also in need of aircrafts for their troops, and Dr Chettiar's flights carried Army personnel, armour, resources and refugees alike.

Dr Chettiar sold his airlines in 1953, a few years before he passed, when the Indian Airlines was nationalised.

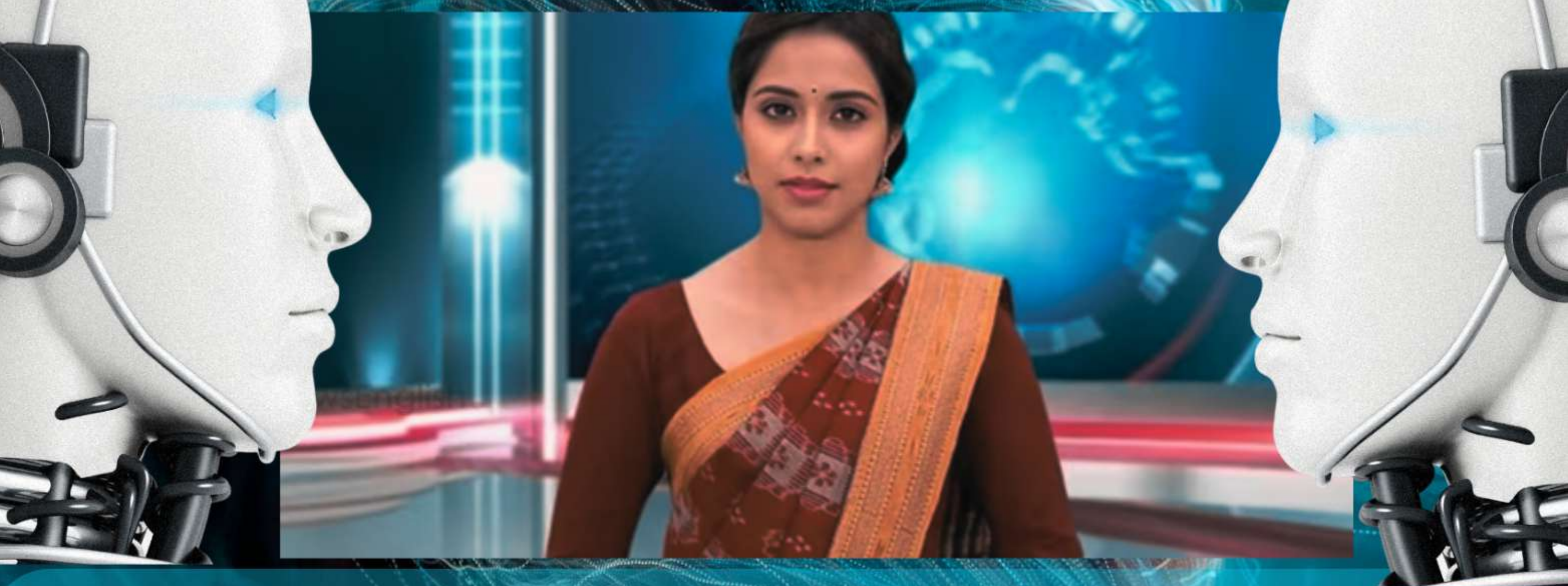

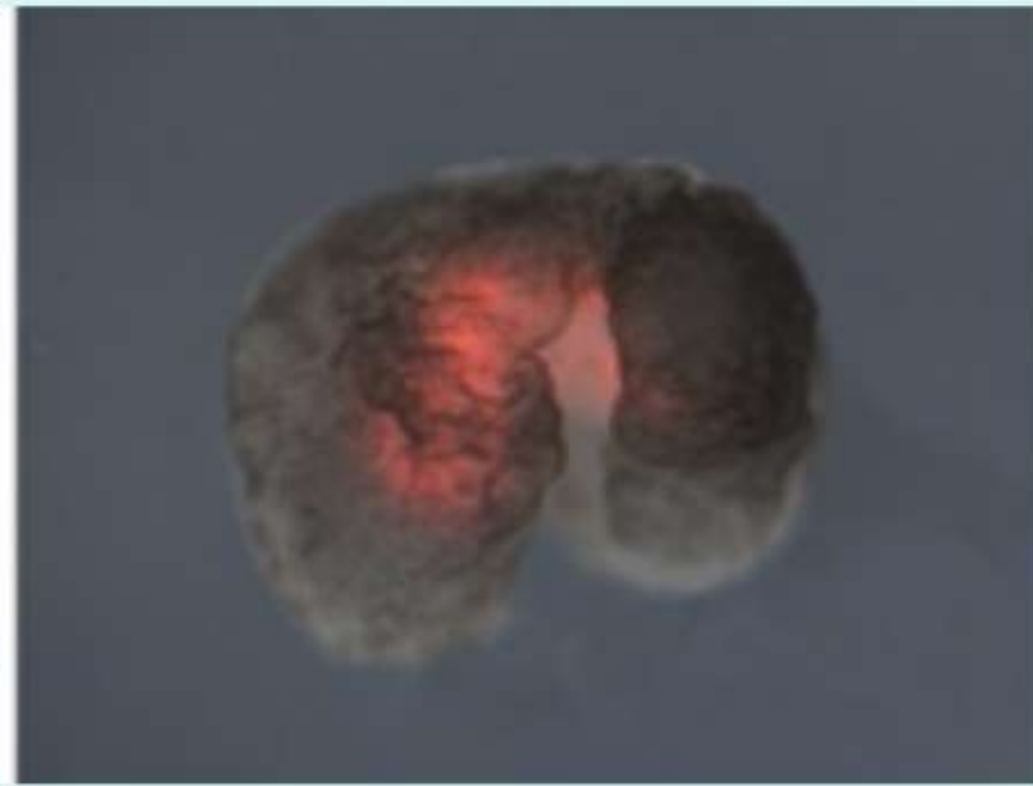
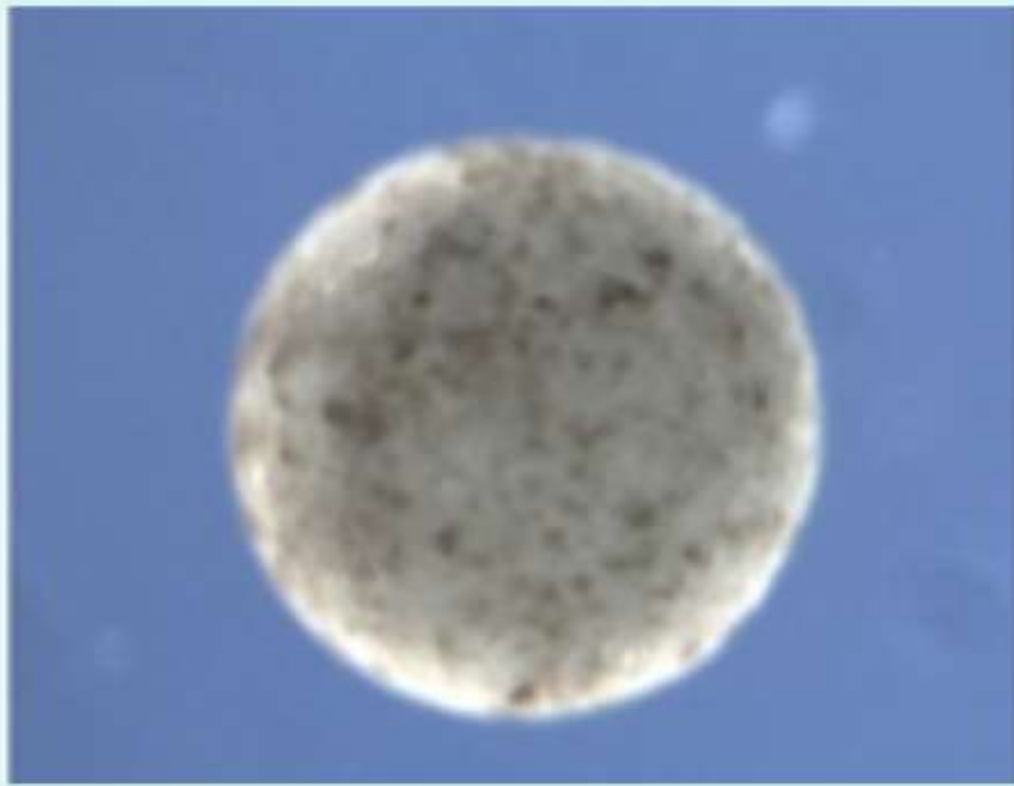
THE XENOBOTS

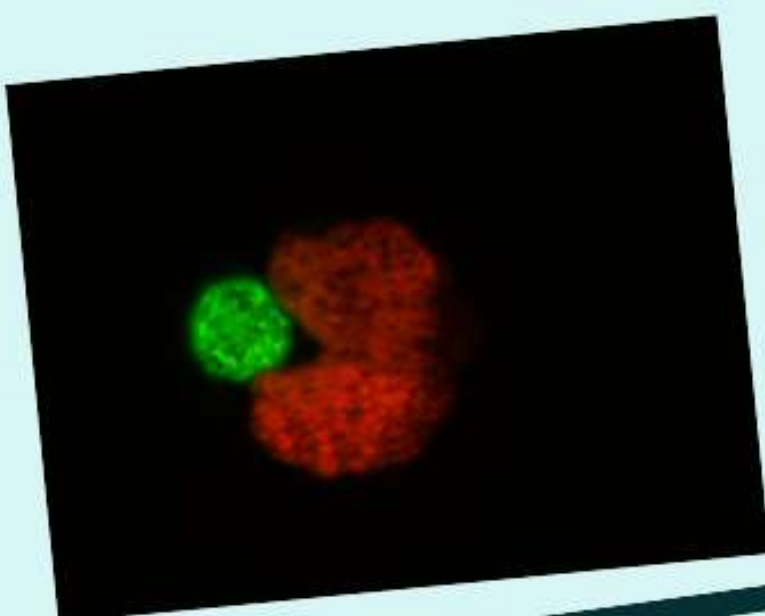
XENOBOTS ARE A REMARKABLE COMBINATION OF ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE & BIOLOGY.



1. Xenobots are not traditional robots. They are living organisms constructed from frog cells. They are created through a combination of biological and computational techniques.

2. These tiny biological machines are less than a millimetre in size and are composed of skin and heart cells from African clawed frogs.

3. They are designed to walk, swim, push pellets, carry payloads and work together in a swarm to aggregate debris scattered along the surface of their dish into neat piles.



4. Xenobots are capable of self-healing. If they are damaged or injured or being torn almost into halves, the cells can regenerate and repair themselves, allowing the robots to continue functioning.

5. Xenobots are biodegradable and environmentally friendly. When they complete their tasks, they naturally decompose and do not leave any waste or harm to the environment.

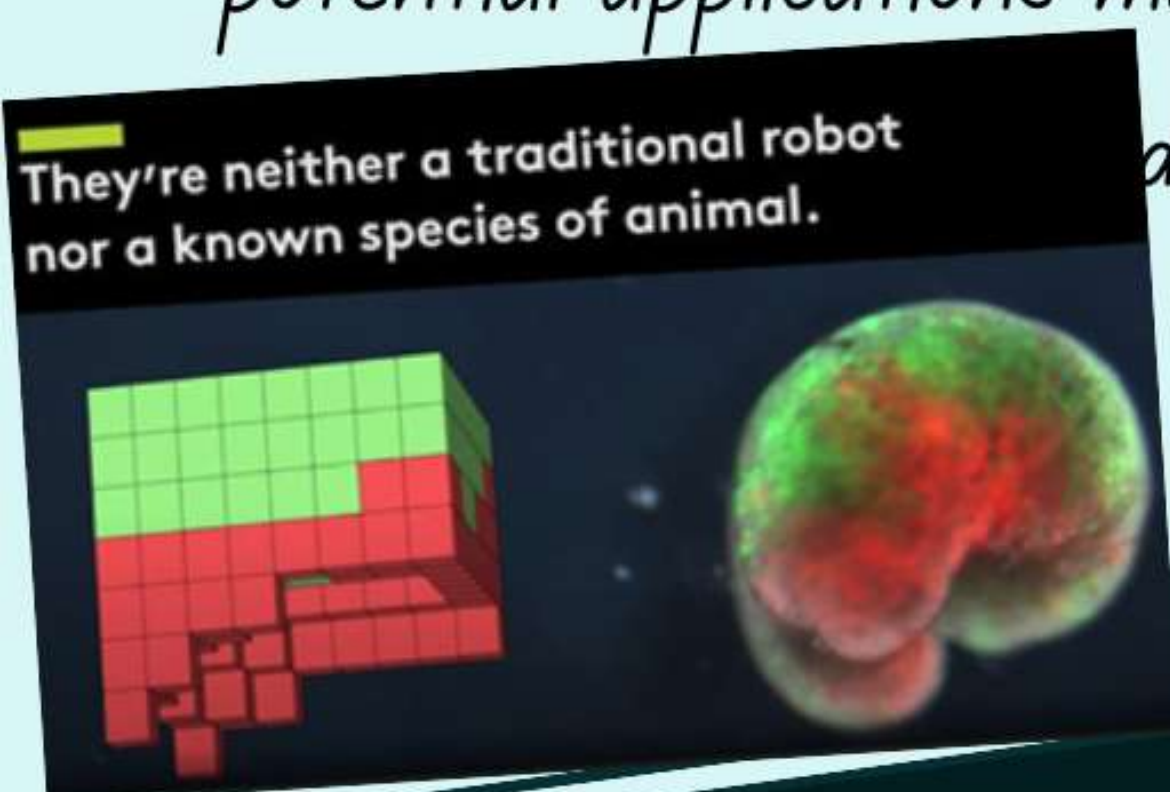
6. These organic robots have the potential to be used in various fields, such as medicine and environmental clean-up.

7. Xenobots can be designed to deliver drugs to specific targets in the body or to remove harmful pollutants from the environment.

8. Ethical considerations are an important aspect of Xenobot research. Scientists are working to ensure that these living machines are used responsibly and in ways that do not harm other forms of life or violate ethical boundaries.

TEMPLES

KAMAKHYA TEMPLE



The Kamakhya Temple at Nilachal hills in Guwahati, Assam is one of the oldest and most revered centres of Tantric practices, dedicated to the goddess Kamakhya.

The temple is peculiar for its annual festival that celebrates the menstruation of the goddess

ACCORDING TO THE KALIKA PURANA, KAMAKHYA TEMPLE DENOTES THE SPOT WHERE SATI USED TO RETIRE IN SECRET TO SATISFY HER AMOUR WITH SHIVA AND IT WAS ALSO THE PLACE WHERE HER YONI (GENITALS, WOMB) FELL AFTER SHIVA TANDAV (DANCE OF DESTRUCTION WITH THE CURSE OF SATI)

Structurally, the temple is dated to the 8th – 9th century with many subsequent rebuildings – and the final hybrid architecture defines a local style called Nilachal. It is also one among the oldest 4 of the 51 pithas in the Shakta tradition. An obscure place of worship for much of history it become an important pilgrimage destination, especially for those from Bengal, in the 19th century during colonial rule.

In July 2015, the Supreme Court of India transferred the administration of the temple from the Kamakhya Debutter Board to the Bordeuri Samaj.



Konark Sun Temple

The Konark Sun Temple is an example of the Nagara styles of Hindu temple architecture. The Nagara temple is square – shaped, containing the sanctum where the deity is housed (The mool) and the pillared assembly hall (The Jagamohana).



One of the most fascinating things of this temple is that the sun idol is suspended in the air as there were magnets used in the construction. So when you entered the main temple, you'd see a tall idol in mid-air.

The Sun temple at Konark exhibits the traditional Odisha style of architecture, also known as Kalinga architecture, on a grand scale. It is designed as a massive chariot mounted on 12 pairs of intricately carved giant stone wheels that are drawn by a set of seven mighty stone horses.

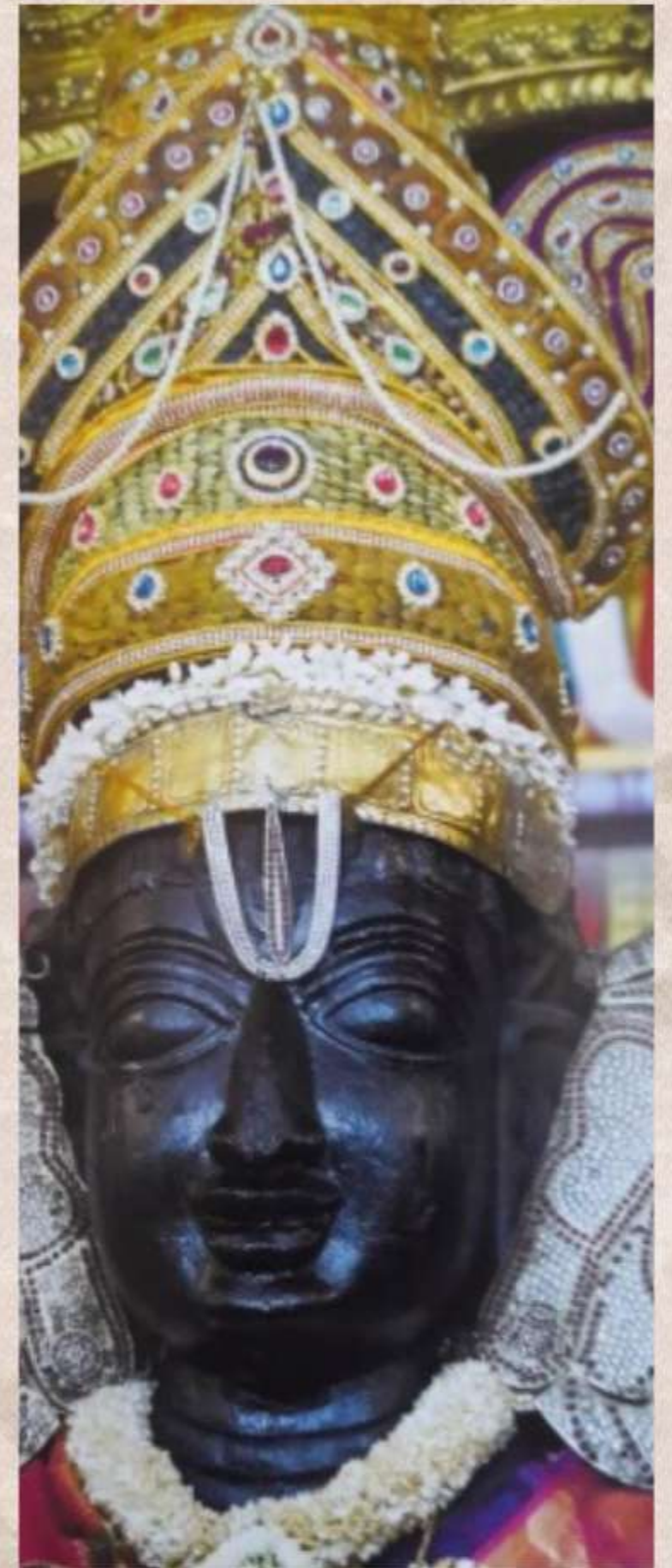

2. It is a remarkable archaeological find that makes the visitors appreciate the importance of the discoveries made there.



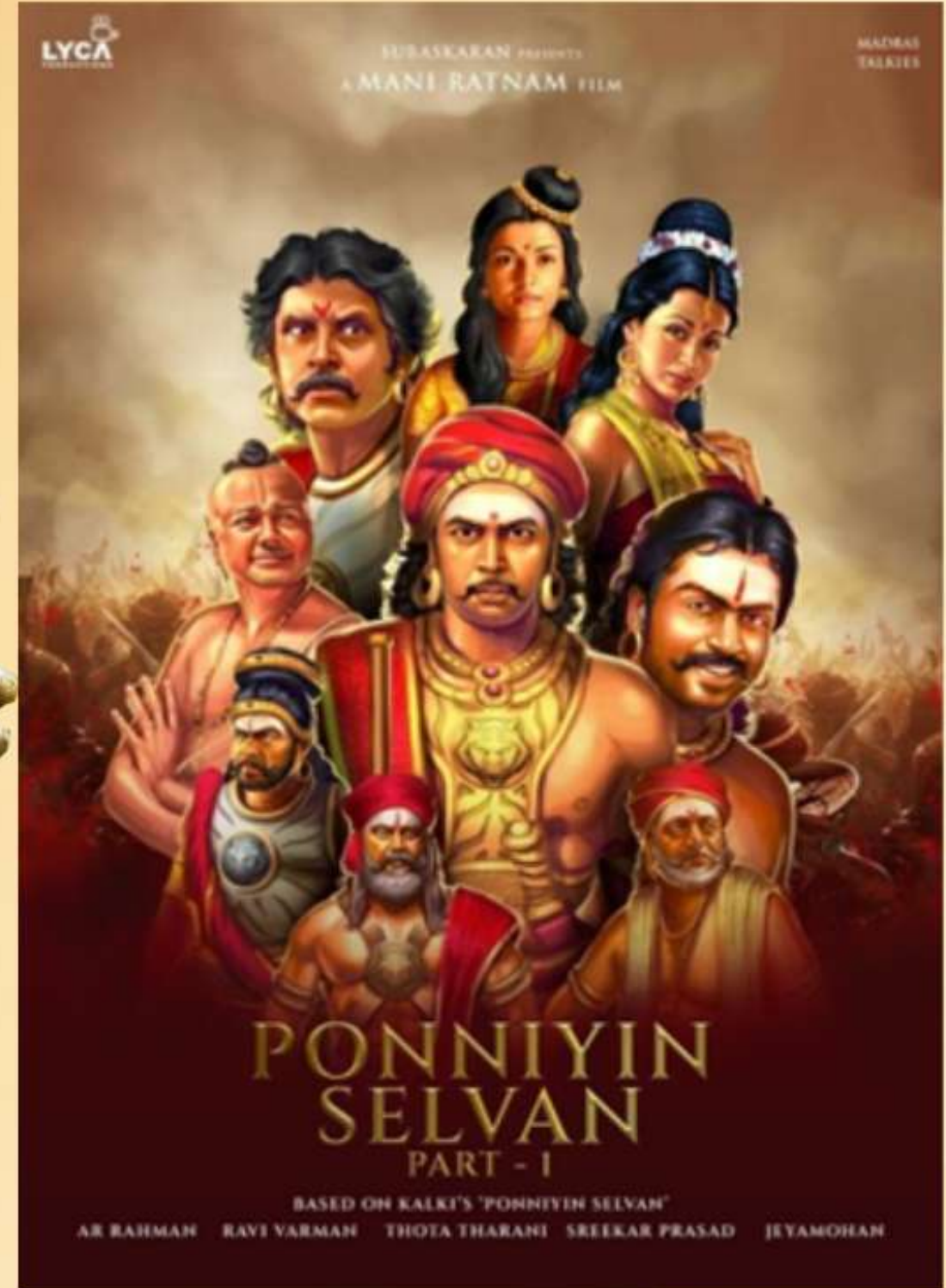
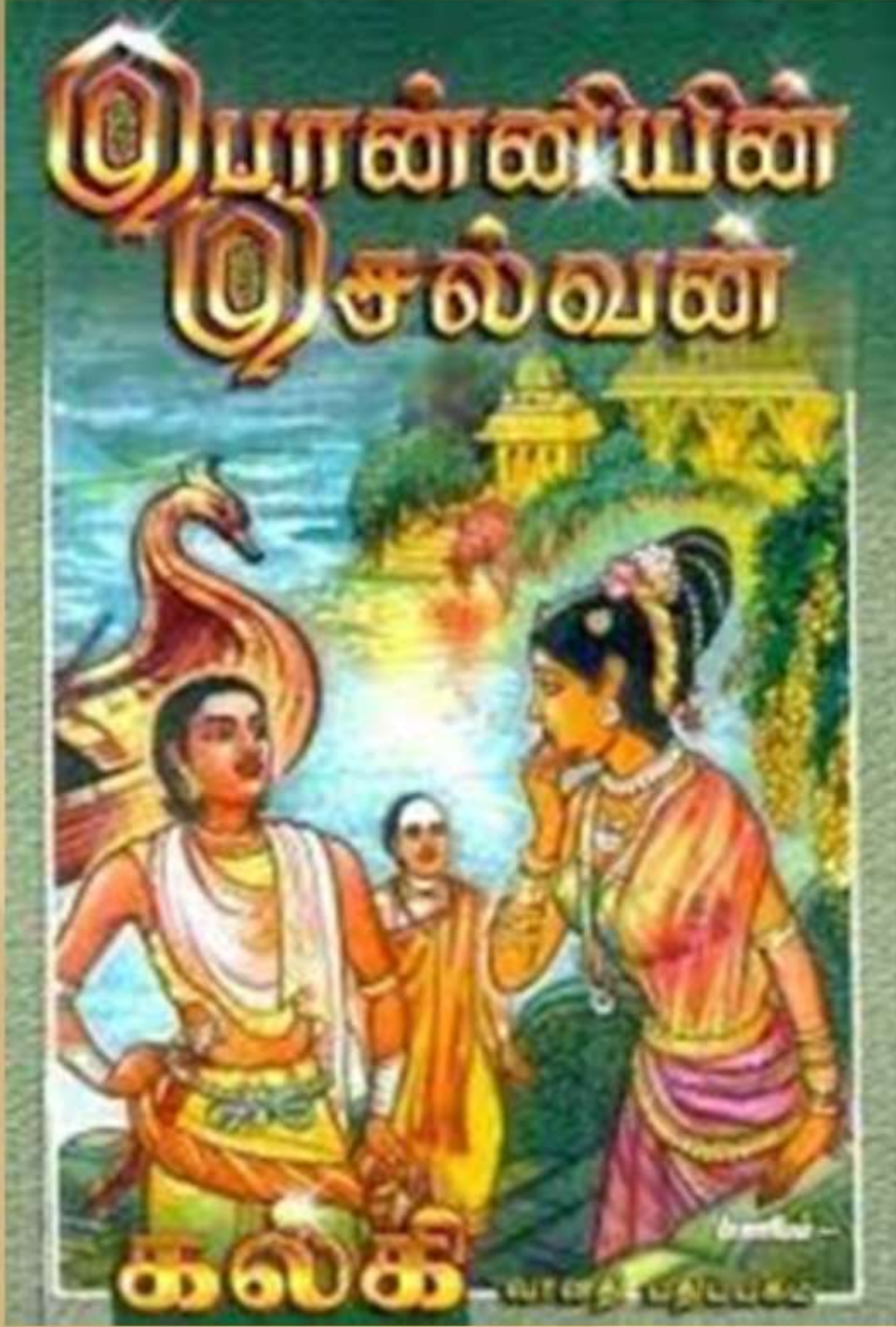

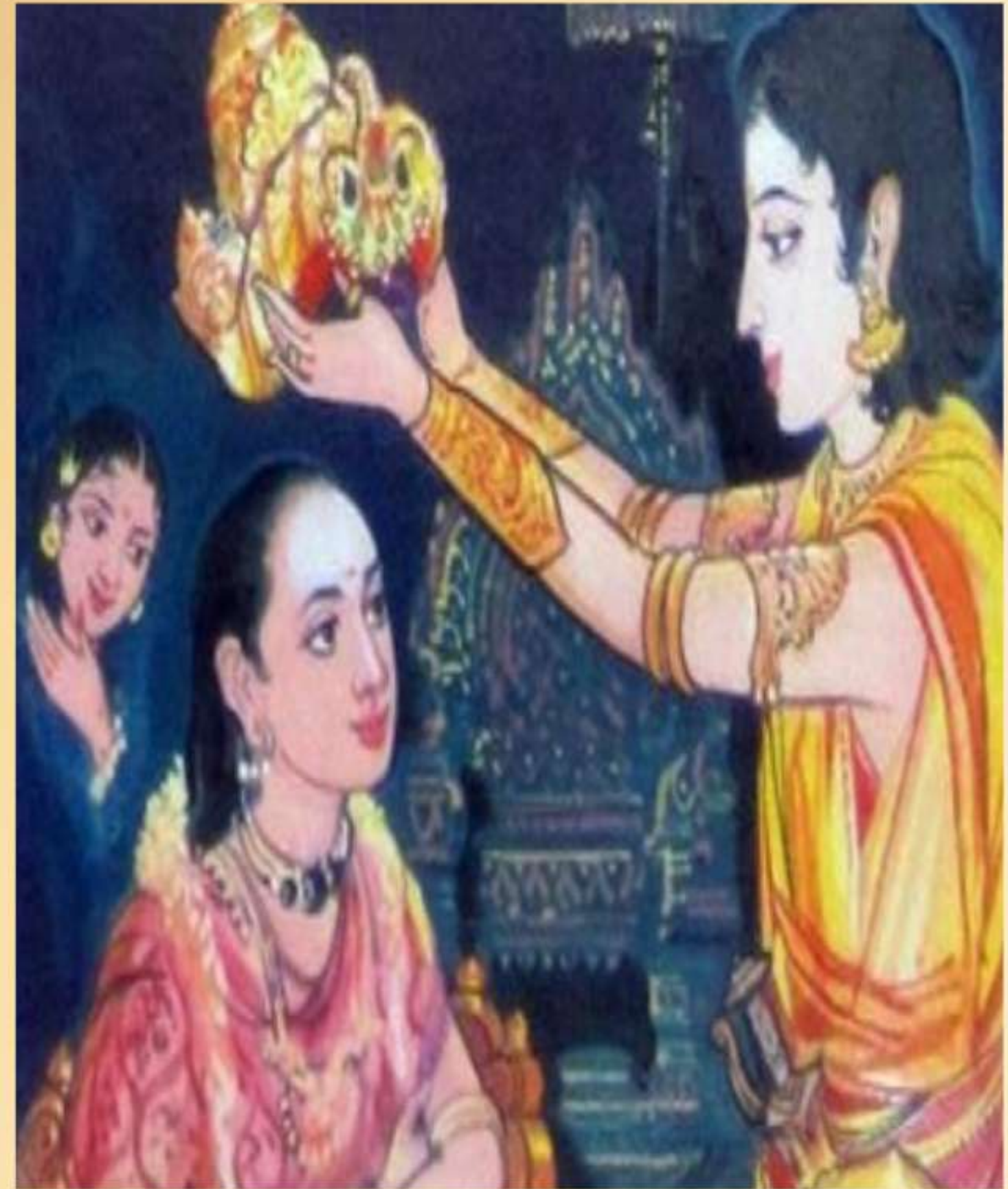
SENDHAN AMUDHAN'S IDENTITY

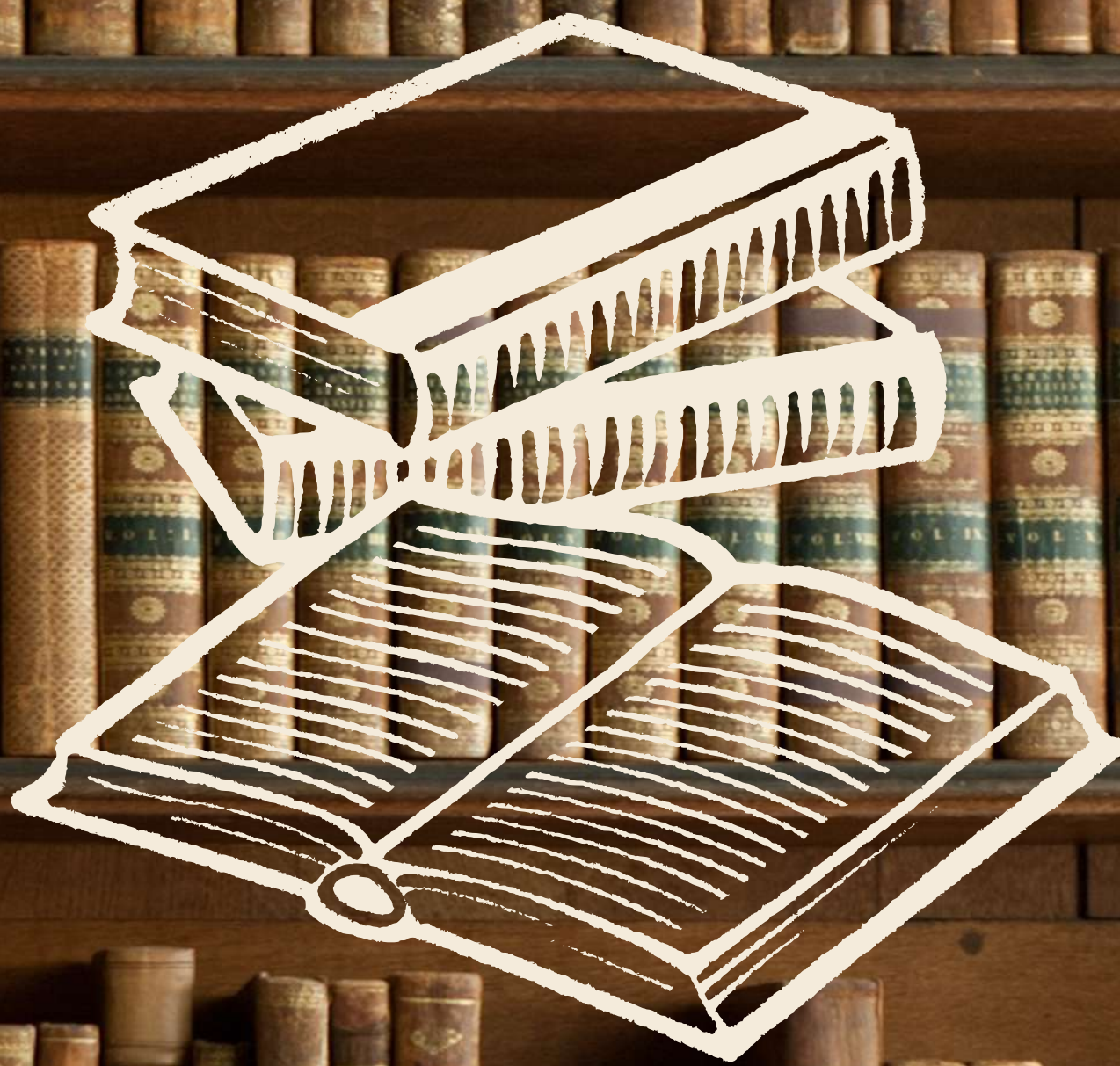
In India, one such project is called 'Project Tiger'. It was launched on April 1, 1973 by the Government of India and it is the largest species conservation program of its kind. The project aims at ensuring a viable population of the Bengal tiger in its natural habitats, protecting it from extinction, and preserving it as a natural heritage that represents the diversity of our country.

The number of tigers in India has increased from 2,967 in 2018 to 3,167 in 2022, according to the figures of the 5th cycle of India's Tiger Census released by our Prime Minister to mark 50 years of Project Tiger on April 9, 2023.


It is part of Indian culture to protect nature. The success of Project Tiger is a matter of pride not only for India but for the whole world. India has completed 75 years of independence; and at the same time, 75 percent of the world's tiger population is in India.




TIME AND TIDE WAIT FOR NONE




God has created everyone equally in this world, whether they are white-skinned or dark-skinned, physically challenged or visually challenged. Everyone in this world is the same to Him.

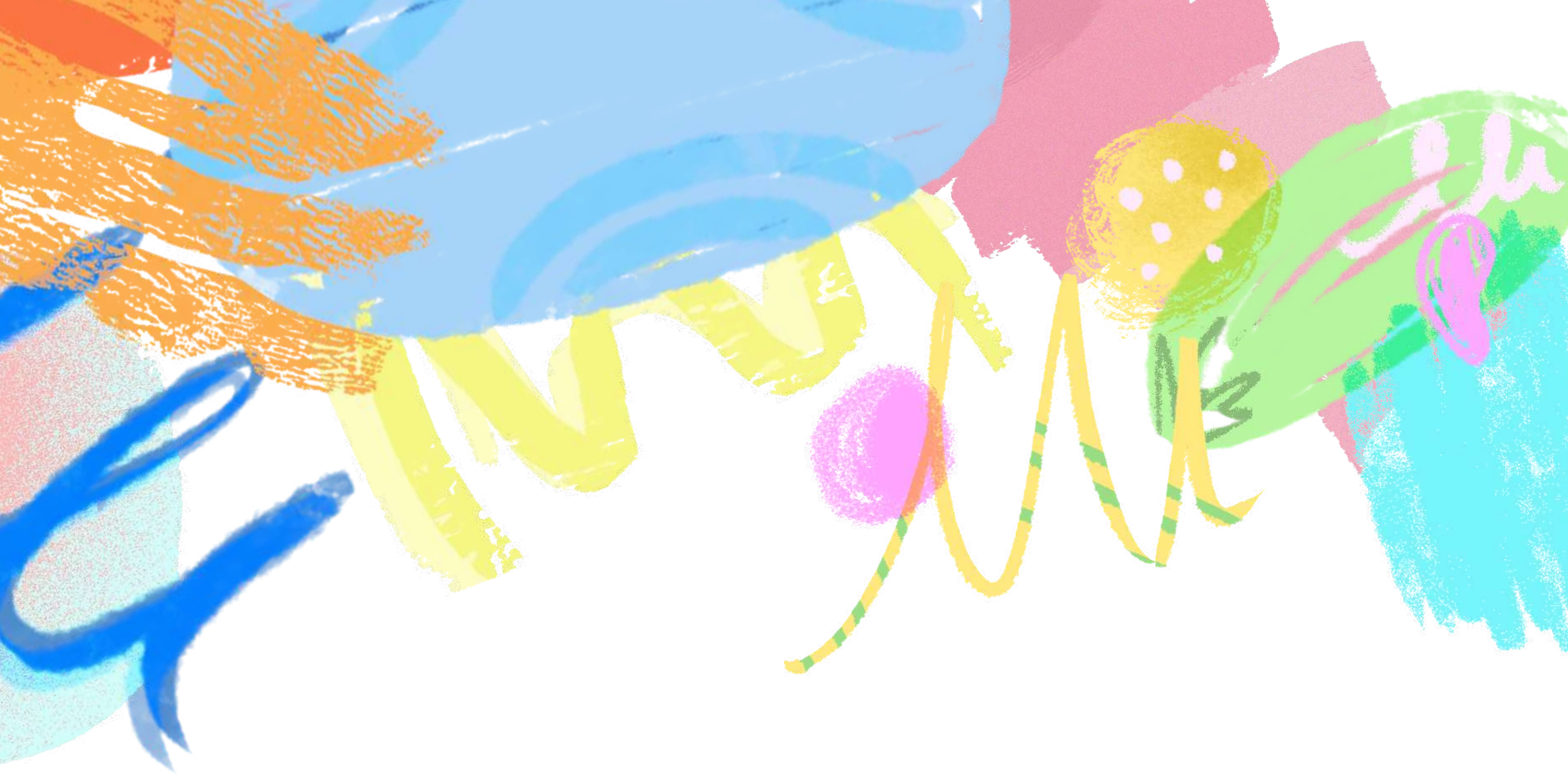

Therefore, I request all of you to treat them equally in your lives and do the best you can. Let us treat everyone equally and be the most beautiful person in the world.

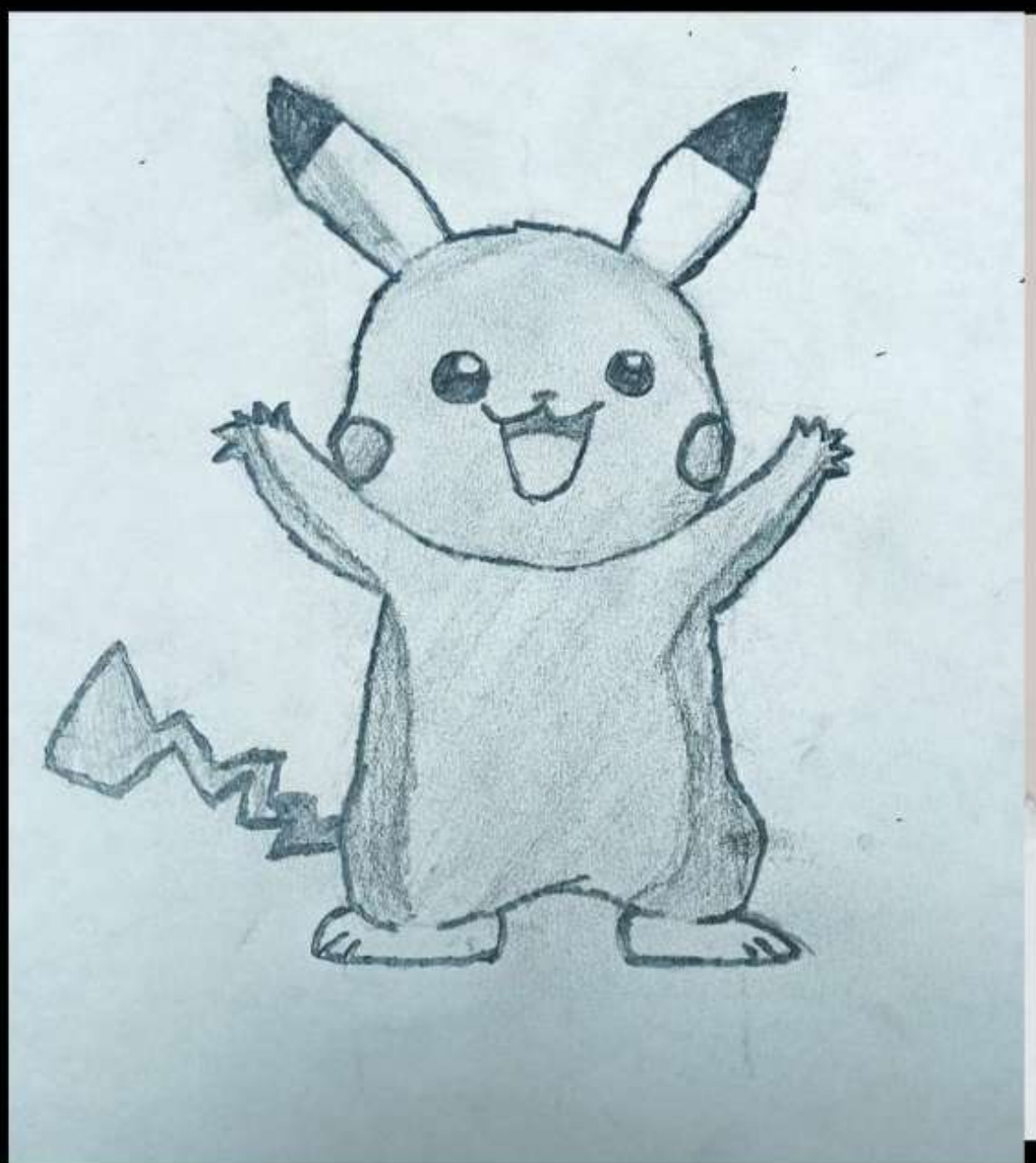


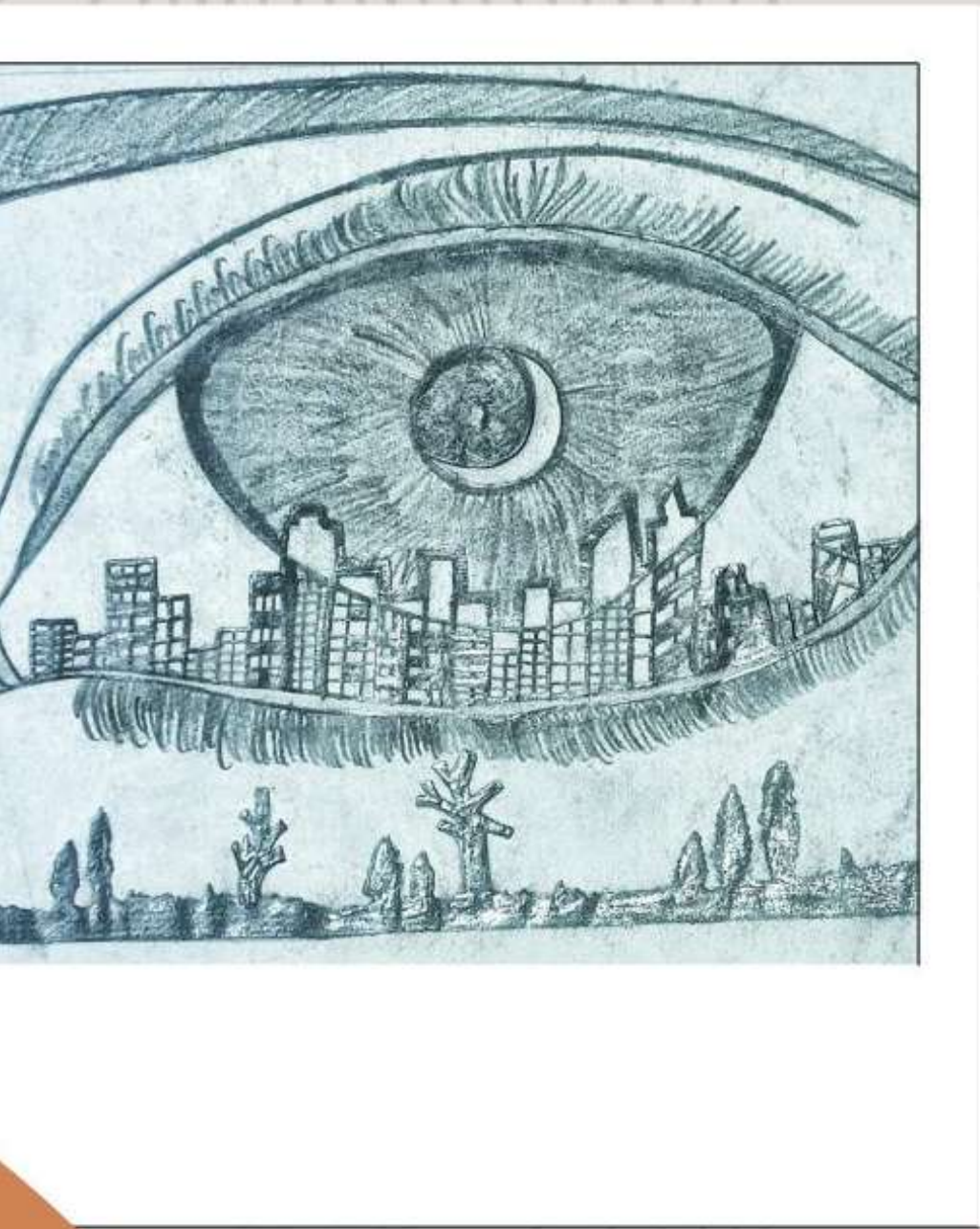
